
Optional Soft Casters for Hard Floor Surfaces

Seat Adjustment Levers: Right Hand Side of Chair

A. Pull up for lift height adjustment

B. Pull up to disengage seat slider.
Push forward to increase seat depth;
backwards to decrease.

Seat Adjustment Lever: Left Hand Side of Chair

C. Push or pull forward to lock the seat and back in 4 positions with anti-kick safety feature. Push or pull rearward for free float control.



The Manhattan Petite is equipped with the "Self-Weighing" chair control that responds to torque requirements covering a wide range of users without the need for tension adjustment.

Arm Height Adjustment: Knob on side of chair arms

E. To adjust the height of the chair arms, push and hold the button while moving the arm up or down. Release the button at the desired height.

Arm Width Adjustment: Lever underneath chair arm

F. Push lever backward to release chair arm adjustment. Arms adjusts outward up to 2 inches. Pull arm inward towards chair to narrow width. Push lever forward to lock into place.
