FLAG CARE AND ETIQUETTE

Thank you for purchasing one of our flags. We would like to offer the following suggestions and cautions to assure you will get the most wear and enjoyment out of your flag.

- Keep your Flag from fraying or tearing by looking at the fly end of the flag for any signs of wear. If necessary trim and re-hem any damaged fabric or threads.
- Flags will collect pollutants with normal use causing it to degrade. Keep your Flag clean for longer use.
- During inclement weather, flags should not be flown or displayed unless they are designed as an ALL WEATHER or STORM flag.
- Flags may be hand washed using a mild detergent. Lay flat or hang evenly to dry.
- Dry clean CEREMONIAL flags. (Some dry cleaners may do this at no cost.)
- NEVER fold , roll up, or store a flag when wet. Wet flags will mildew and ruin the fabric.
- The Flag may be flown 24 hours, 7 days a week, as long as it is illuminated properly.
